Conditions of Entry

1. All horses must be registered with the Arabian Horse Society of Australia. Registration numbers to be stated for exhibits on Entry forms. **A photocopy of both sides of the registration certificate must accompany entries.**
2. The Queensland Arabian Saddle Horse of the Year Show is conducted under the Rules and Regulations as set down by the Arabian Horse Society of Australia as per Rule Book 2007 and the Rules herein.
3. Conduct: Any horse deemed to be loose or out of control, or a danger to others will be excused from the ring.
4. No stallion is to be handled or ridden by a person under 18 years of age.
5. Rules and Regulations of AHSA LTD shall define youth competitors. A copy of the Birth certificate must be supplied with entry forms for all Youth Riders.
6. Where there is a choice of both Youth and Open classes, youth riders must decide to ride EITHER Youth or Open Classes NOT BOTH. (It is possible for a horse to enter both, with a Youth Rider for Youth Classes and an Open rider for Open Classes). Classes numbered 1-10 and class 19-28 are open to all riders, any age (except for Youth classes and as per rule 4).
7. All Youth must wear Safety Approved helmets in all classes.
8. All riders must wear appropriate headgear and footwear whilst competing or riding in the warm-up area.
9. The organizing Committee reserves the right to refuse any nomination without having to assign any reason.
10. Entry fees shall accompany the entry form and are NOT REFUNDABLE.
11. All protests must be submitted in writing to the Disputes Committee not later than thirty (30) minutes following the completion of the event in question. A fee of \$50.00 shall accompany all protests. The following persons may lodge protest - Competitors or Exhibitors in the disputed Class or any Show Official.
12. **Any protests regarding the qualification of a Newcomer Horse will only be heard upon payment of applicable protest fee and dispute in writing with written proof of horses non-comforming to qualification**
13. The Show organizer shall have the power to without assigning any reason to:
 - a. Reject or cancel any entry at any time
 - b. **Cancel any event or class, divide or combine classes in relation to entries received or transfer any exhibit from one class to another**
 - c. Remove any exhibit from the grounds
14. The Judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into..
15. Newcomer classes 1 and 2: all entries for these classes must be accompanied by a completed (signed and witnessed by Justice of the Peace) Statutory Declaration (see back of entry form to the effect that the horse has never been shown under saddle prior to 10th September 2009. All Newcomer horses must be ridden in an AHSA LTD Approved Snaffle Bit. Newcomer horses are eligible to compete in their respective Open classes.
16. Any cheque received or accepted by the Organizer shall be deemed to have been received as conditional payment only and subject to payment upon presentation.
17. All horses entered in a Class must be presented to work on the circle as a group. A change of riders is allowable for the individual workouts.
18. No exhibit may leave the marshalling area once their class has commenced.
19. Classes are open to horses which are three years and over. **Horses used for Lead Line are to be a minimum of 4 years of age as per AHSA rules.**
20. Please refer to the current AHSA LTD Rule Book for rules governing tack, attire and class procedure.
21. Lead Line rider under 8. Rider can not compete in any other class. All horses used for this class must be registered with the AHSA Ltd
22. Junior Judging Saddle Horse. This is a Judging of Saddle horse class and will take some time during the morning classes. It is open to competitors 25 years and under and will be split if there are sufficient entries
23. The final Order of events will be issued in the Final Programme. There may be changes to allow for gear, rider and horse changes.

Horse Sports are a Dangerous Activity

In consideration for being permitted to participate in any way in horse sport activities and in particular this event, I, the undersigned, understand, acknowledge and accept that:

Horse sports are a dangerous recreational activity and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable (changeable) way, especially if frightened or hurt.

There is a significant risk that serious **INJURY** or **DEATH** may result from horse sport activities and in particular this event.

I knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of the proprietors of the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Ltd and/or the event organiser (hereafter referred to as the "Releasees") or others and I **voluntarily PARTICIPATE** at my **OWN RISK** and assume sole responsibility for any injury, death or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in horse sport activities.

I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before and during the activity and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption. I agree not to drink alcohol or take drugs prohibited by law before or during this event.

I agree to follow the directions of any event organiser or official and that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction of any organiser or official can result in the **CANCELLATION** of my participation in the event and my immediate removal from my horse **NO MATTER** where that may occur. I further agree to abide by the Rules and Conditions of this show and the official Rule Book of the Arabian Horse Society of Australia. I understand that any such non-compliance may result in injury, death and/or permanent disability and I agree to indemnify the Releasees against all claims made by any person as a result of my failure to comply.

I agree to wear a helmet at all times whilst riding and agree that I am solely responsible for ensuring that I wear a suitable helmet at all times while riding and take sole responsibility for my actions.

I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby release and hold harmless and agree not to sue the proprietors of the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Ltd and/or the event organiser, their officers, officials, volunteers, coaches, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, state bodies, affiliated clubs and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the activities (all of whom are referred to as "Releasees") with respect to any and all injury, disability, death, or loss or damage to person or property, whether caused by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise.

I understand that due to diseases such as equine influenza, the Department of Primary Industries, or other state or commonwealth government bodies may restrict or prevent the movement of horses, vehicles and personnel for a time period, otherwise known as a "standstill". I acknowledge that a standstill is a risk of competing and agree to pay any costs or expenses incurred by any person or organisation for and on behalf of my horse(s) as a result of the standstill.

Effect of this Document - I have had sufficient opportunity to read this release of liability and assumption of risk agreement, fully understand its terms, understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it, and sign it freely and voluntarily without inducement of any kind. I understand that my signature to this document constitutes a complete and unconditional release of all liability of the Releasees, to the greatest extent allowed by law in the event of me and/or the children under my care, suffering injury or death.
